

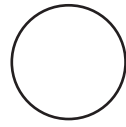


Ring size guide

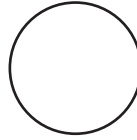
Use a ring you know fits and line it up against the UK ring sizes below. Your size is the one that matches the inside edge of your ring.

The diameters are given for each ring size if you find it easier to measure the inside diameter of your ring.

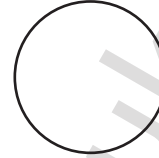
Print on A4 paper and ensure your printer is set to 100% scale. It is advised that before you use the size guide you check it has printed correctly by using the scale at the bottom of the page.



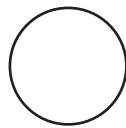
